

ROCK STARZ Parents CODE OF ETHICS

Rock Starz Code of Conduct: Each parent will ensure that his/her conduct is that of a lady or gentleman while at all competitions and after their conclusion. To satisfactorily meet these responsibilities, the spectator is expected to:

- Respect the rules put in place at the Rock Starz gym, and while attending competitions.
- Respect the judges and refrain from questioning their decisions or from addressing them in a loud, disrespectful, or abusive manner.
- Cheer for your team in a positive, supportive manner, refraining at all times from making hostile, negative, or abusive remarks about the opposing cheer teams.
- Refrain at all times from coming onto the performance floor or warm-up areas. .
- Demonstrate appropriate gestures of sportsmanship at the conclusion of all competitions.
- Realize, accept and practice the principle that a team's reputation is built not only on its ability but also on sportsmanship, and courtesy of its parents.
- Respect the coaches after an event and allow them 24 hours to respond about a potential issue or complaint.
- All conversations involving complaints with your child's coaches must be set up by the program director. This includes immediately after a competition, or away at an overnight event.
- When away at an overnight competition, your children are expected to represent the program, and they are expected to act and behave as they would on a school trip/activity. We ask that all parents follow these rules as well.
- If your child behaves in a manner that she has to be removed from a competition, it will be up to the parent(s) to take the

child home. Consequences from that behavior and all behaviors will be handled, and the final result could be removal from the program permanently.

- Email communication - Parents are not permitted to use Rock Starz email as a form of accordingly soliciting for personal events or issues. *“Reply All” emails are not permitted.*
- Social Media such as Facebook/twitter etc... - When using this form of communication, please be positive at all times, and cognizant of the safety of our coaches and our kids. We do not want any outside misinterpretations from the public, or strangers who have ill-advised thoughts.
- Email/Text Complaints - Rock Starz will not welcome complaints via email or text. Please use the email/text to schedule a meeting to discuss a complaint in person or by phone.
- Complaints & issues should go to the program director first before contacting NAC management. If a resolution is not attained, a meeting w/ NAC management will be scheduled.
- Be positive! Negativity grows and spreads like a cancer. Even our youngest cheerleaders are effected by negativity. If it isn't nice, please think twice about saying it!

I agree to abide by the Rock Starz Code of Conduct whenever participating in a Rock Starz sponsored activity. I also acknowledge that failure to follow the Code of Conduct could result in permanent removal of the cheerleader immediately, and there will be no refund.
